## TRANSITIONING HEALTH NUMBERS

Throughout our transition period, our numbers are not conclusive as to how many youth and adults received care regarding physical health services, mental health services and dental services. Head of the Lakes

United Way actively funds and partners with thirteen community agencies that specialize in these fields. Throughout 2018-2020, 84% of people requested information regarding mental health, reducing stress, improving relationships and resources regarding addiction and chemical dependency the most.
